# VCaps in Trebel Section at the Crossovers

After inspecting the crossovers of my speakers, it was found that those have Solen capacitors. First, my decision was to upgrade the 25uf caps, in the mid-section, with 24uf Sonicaps, certainly, after it wasn't possible to detect the little brightness and grain around the notes that it had before. The mids, are more musical and sweeter. More recently, the 4.7 uf Solens, at the treble section were replaced with 4.7 uf Oil and Cooper Vcaps, in the design of these speakers, the mid section and the treble are connected to the same inductor. The Vcaps, requires a long burning period, so they were connected to a DuoTech(devise used to burn cables) for 72 hours, and them installed. Let me tell, that the VCaps, are worth every dollar you paid for it. The improvement in the music tone, presentation of the instruments, sweetness, details, it is beyond my expectations, due to the configuration of the crossovers, the treble and the mids, improved together. Now, it is in consideration, to install, as a by-pass for the 24uf cap. serving the mid-section a 0.22 uf VCaps.
