They're very good for the price, but not the best sounding coupling caps in the world. We use them as coupling caps in the Seduction because they are compact, they match the RIAA caps we use and they are very cost effective for the performance level. Our philosophy has always been that the first thing a customer is going to hack in our kits is the coupling caps, because anyone at any skill level can do it. So we put in something with a good dielectric that works

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well, but doesn't make the customer feel like they are wasting expensive parts when they upgrade. The hardcore guys cough up the dough and go to Auricaps, or Jupiters, or my current fave in the Sed, the Teflon and tinfoil V-caps (a set of which costs as much as the kit does). As far as I know the ECQP/Us are not foil, they are metallized film.
